2. The Applicant must show proof of enrolment as a full-time student in one of the above- mentioned programs.
3. The Applicant must complete the application form (which can be obtained from your NBCC/CCNB Instructor).
4. The Applicant must provide a recent colour photo, with their application, to SE Mutual for possible publication.
5. The Applicants must not have received any scholarship monies from SE Mutual Insurance prior to this submission (applicants may receive only one scholarship from SE Mutual).

Applications must have a fully completed and approved application form and have submitted it to the office of SE Mutual by the required time and date specified above. A copy of the paid tuition, a letter from the school or institution, or a photocopy of the student card are all examples of acceptable proof of registration.
